Elephant Point is an exclusive private estate situated on a 290 ha private reserve bordering the Kruger National Park. The estate is a 5-hour drive from Johannesburg or 60 minutes from the Mpumalanga Kruger airport following a 45-minute flight from Johannesburg.

The area surrounding Elephant Point is renowned for its natural diversity and concentration of the Big Five and is undoubtedly one of the best game viewing areas in the Kruger National Park.

The estate takes its name from the large elephant that can frequently be seen drinking and grazing on the banks of the Sabie River.

In addition you will see herds of buffalo, prides of lion, leopards, hippo and numerous antelope species.

The development has been zoned to ensure that owners and their guests may take long walks in protected areas where they can interact with various antelope species, watch birds or simply experience nature without fear of confronting one of the Big Five.

Ultimate Luxury in the African Bush

It is proposed to develop Elephant Point in 3 stages. The first phase comprises 29 private lodges on the western half of the property. This will be followed by 31 private lodges on the eastern side, with a 60-room hotel completing the third phase. A 30-bed tented camp is also planned.

All buildings will conform to stringent environmental and design standards as set out in a comprehensive Environmental Management Plan.

Stands vary in size from 1 500 m² to 3 000 m². Each site has been carefully selected and most have scenic views of the Sabie River and Kruger National Park. The spacious thatched lodges will blend unobtrusively into the environment, with rich African earth tone exteriors and stone cladding features. A selection of designs will enable investors to express their personal taste and style while ensuring every need is satisfied.

The interiors are lavish in their simplicity, yet opulent in their luxury, and the traditional bush décor offers a soothing and relaxing bushveld feel. The use of natural materials and fabrics complements the unique environment, creating an atmosphere you will want to experience again and again.

Meet the Hoxane Community


